

White Blood Cell Colouring Sheet

Oh no – we've forgotten to label these for you – can you work it out from the clues?

(Clue – the nucleus is in the centre of the cell; it's the control centre!)

- 1) Plasma cell: this makes your antibodies and it has a nucleus which looks like a clock-face
- 2) Neutrophil: this fights bacteria; it has 3 lobes to its nucleus
- 3) Eosinophil: this fights parasites; this has 2 lobes for its nucleus
- 4) Monocyte: this mops up damage; this nucleus looks like a kidney bean
- 5) Lymphocyte: these fight all infections; this nucleus fills the whole cell!
